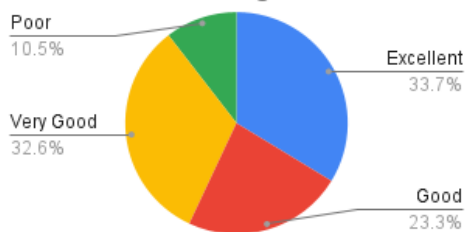

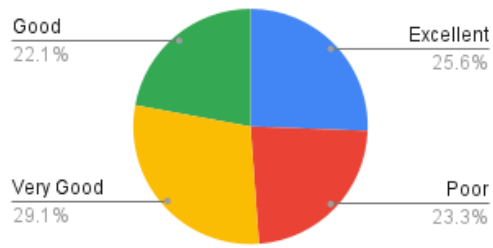
Practical Knowledge
